EARLY CHILDHOOD SOLUTION PLAN RESULTS (GOALS)

Prenatally through age 3, children's age-appropriate development toward kindergarten readiness will be monitored, and services and supports will be provided as needed.

NAZ-enrolled children ages 3 through 5 will make adequate progress toward developing literacy, numeracy, social-emotional and other skills that contribute to kindergarten readiness

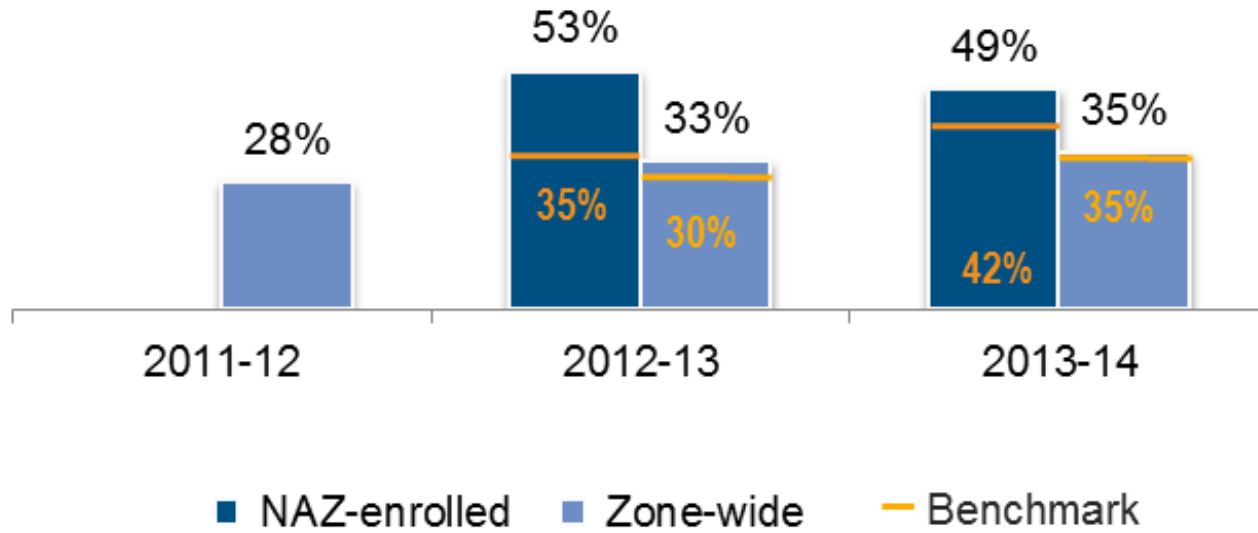
How Are We Doing?

KINDERGARTEN READINESS FINDINGS

- ❖ ***NAZ-enrolled kindergartners arrive in kindergarten more ready to learn than non-enrolled students.***
- ❖ ***NAZ scholars met or exceeded early childhood benchmarks two years in a row (2012-13 and 2013-14).***

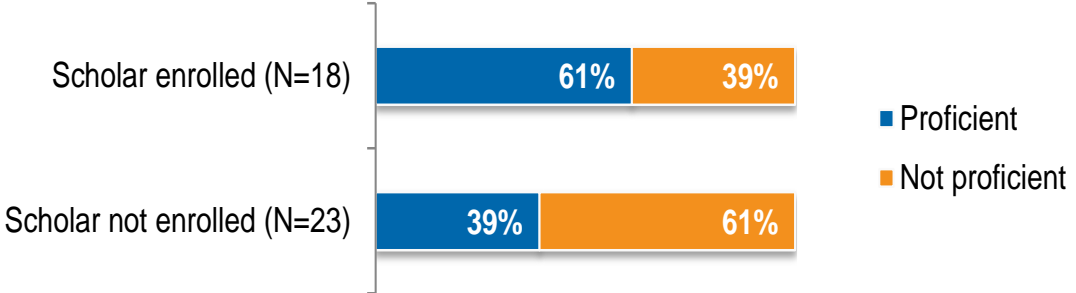
NAZ-ENROLLED KINDERGARTENERS ARRIVE AT SCHOOL MORE READY TO LEARN THAN THEIR PEERS

High Quality Early Childhood Center Enrollment

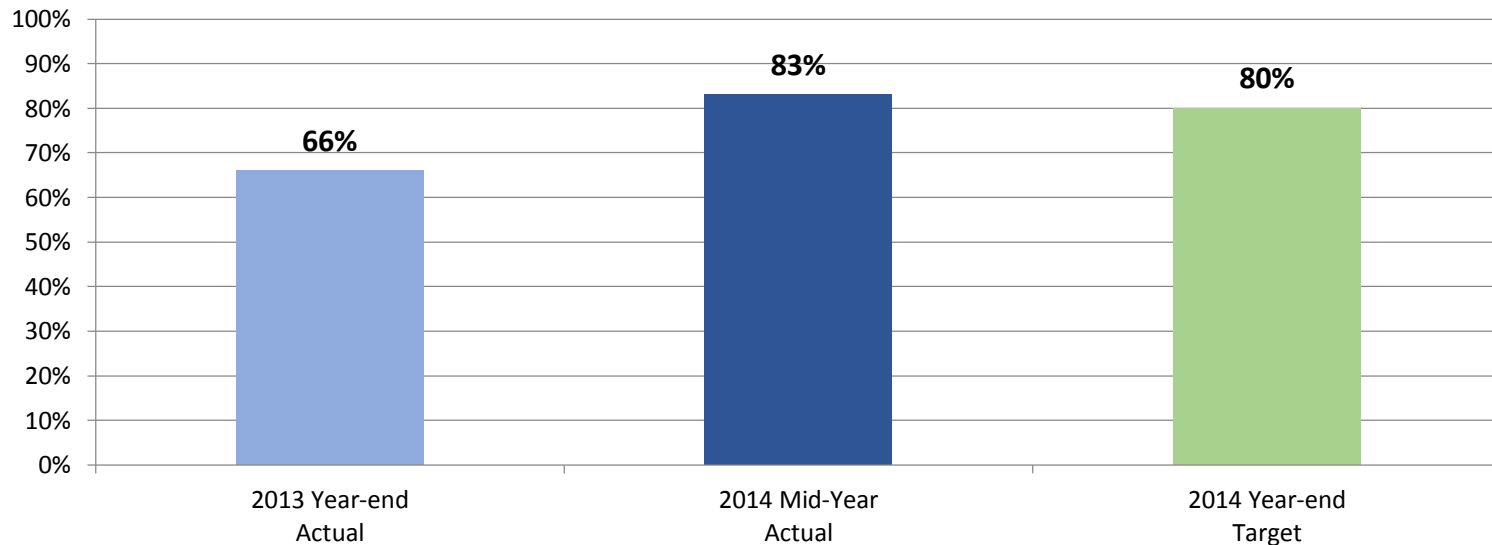

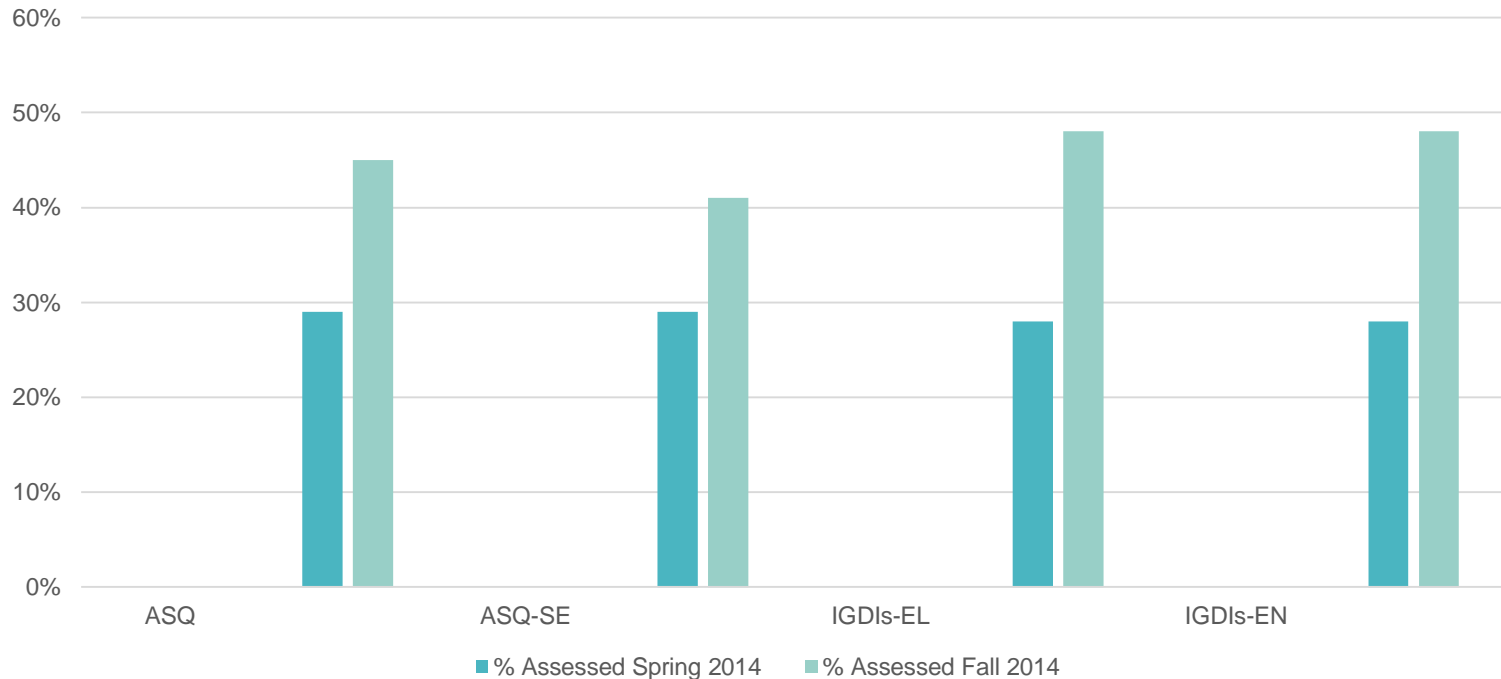

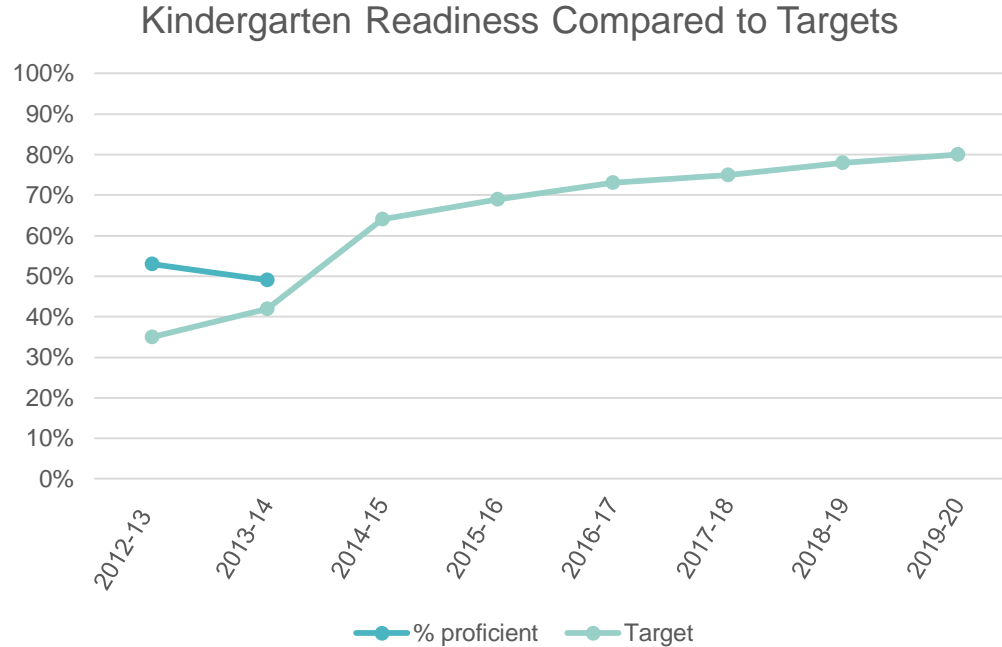

Early childhood screening every 6 months



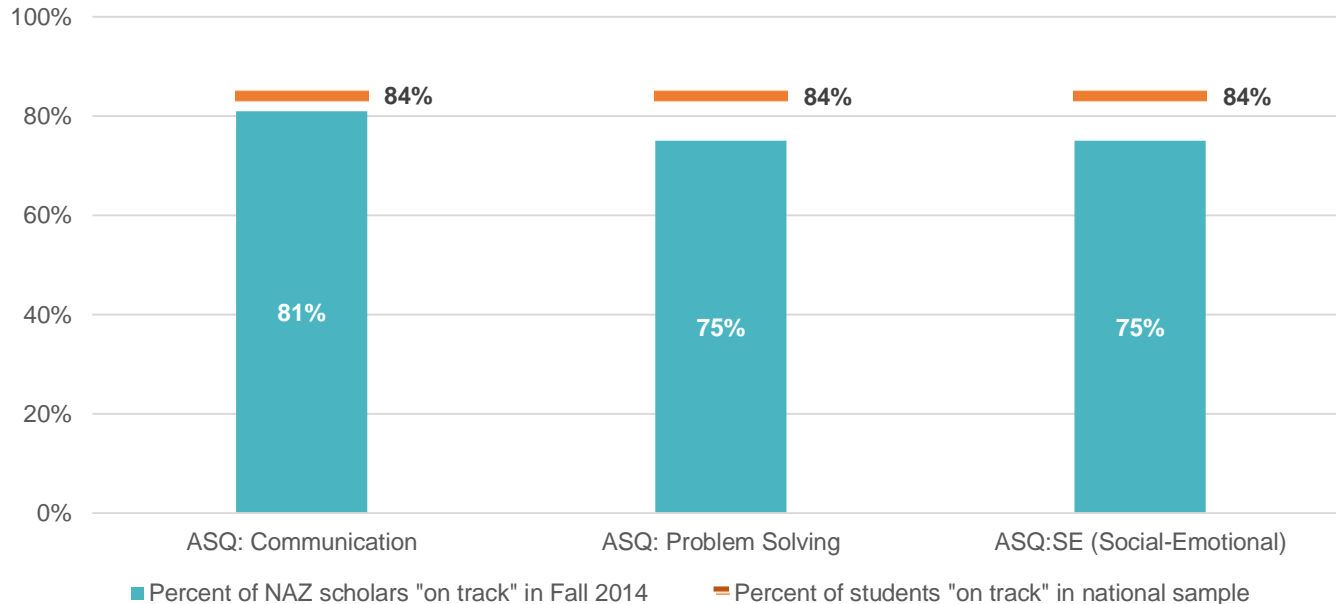

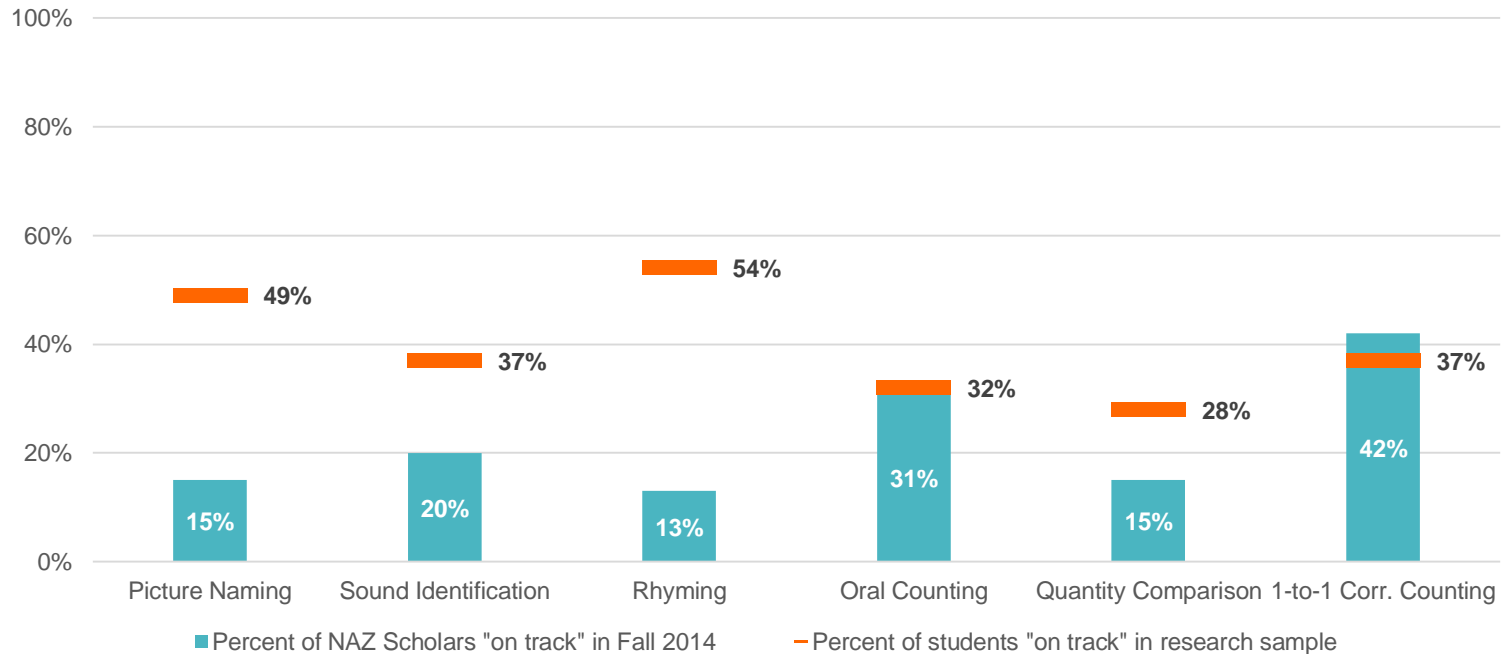
Ages and Stages Questionnaire

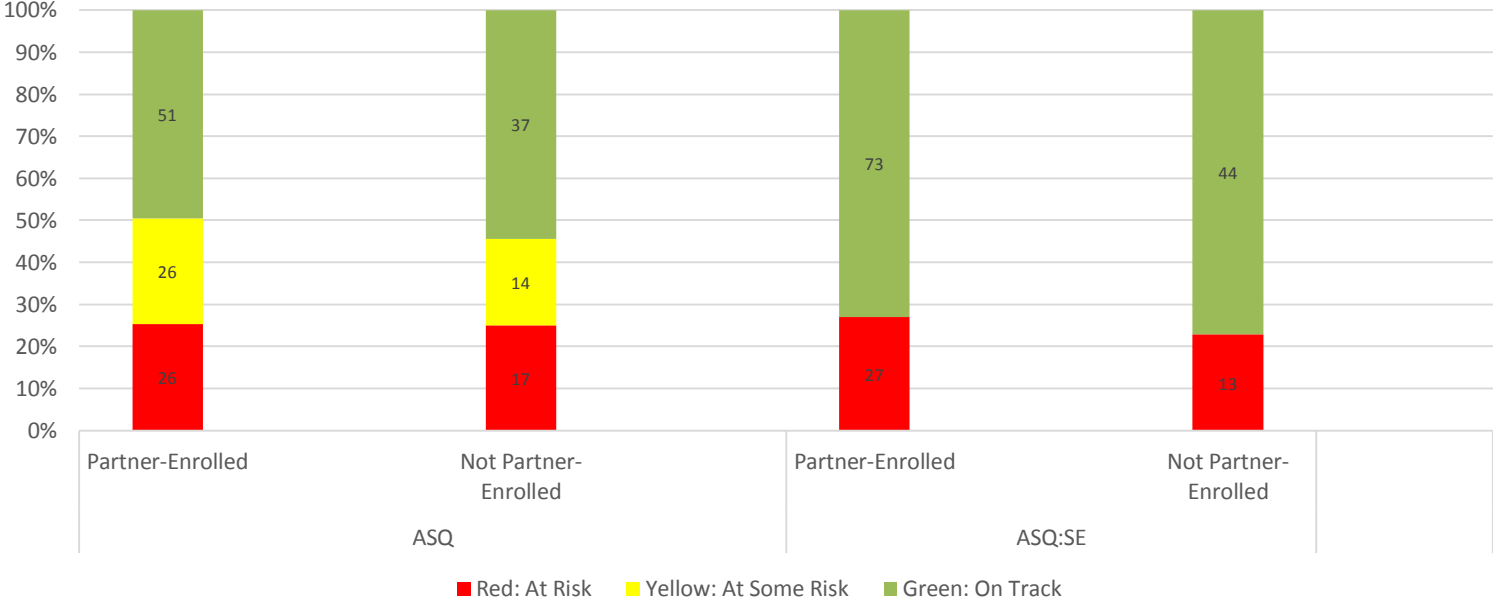

Proficiency Levels by Anchor Partner Enrollment



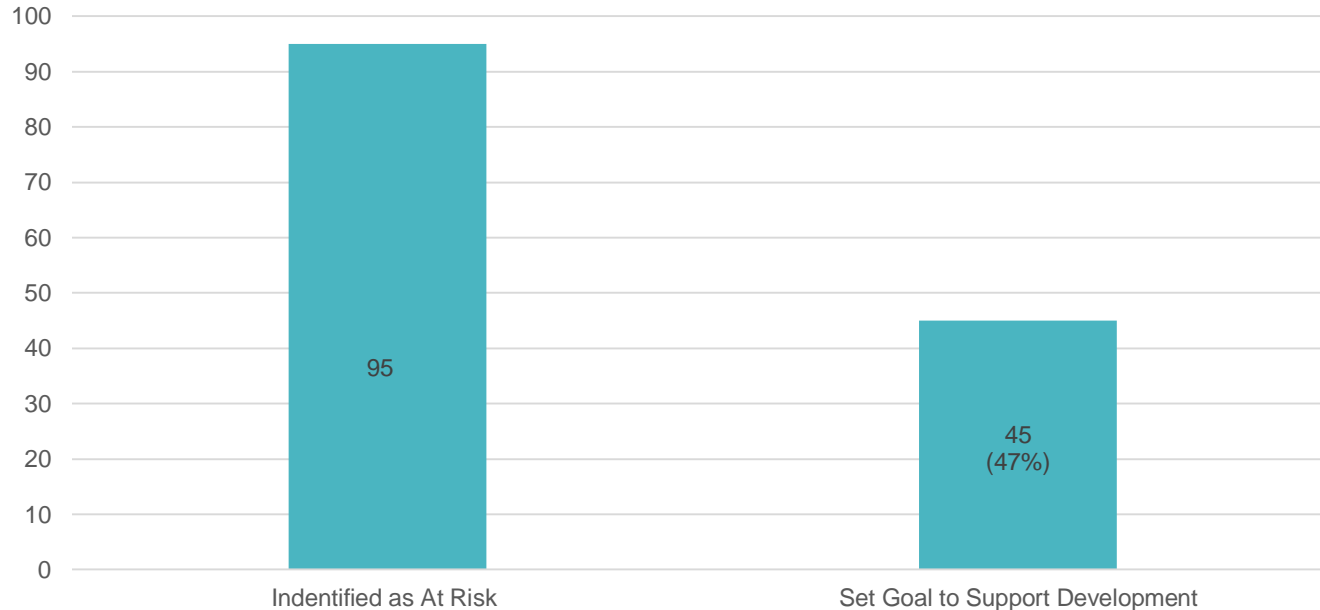

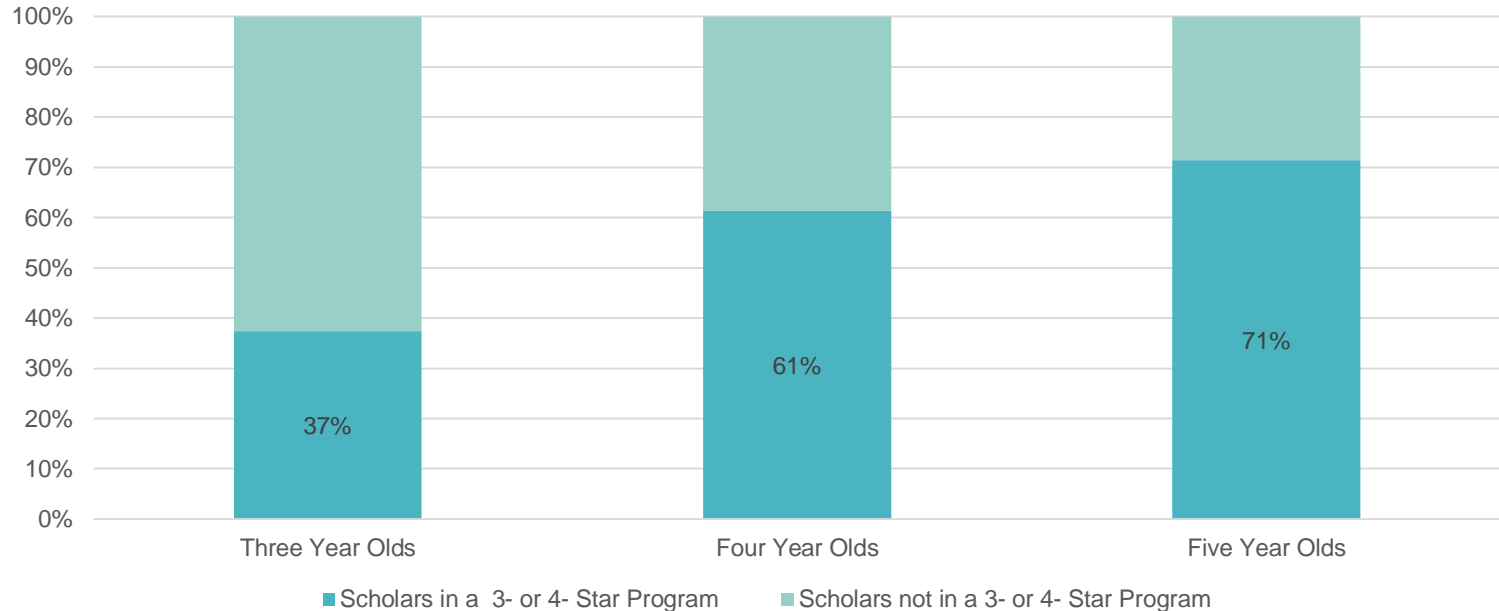

Percent of 3-5 Year Olds Enrolled in High Quality EC Programs

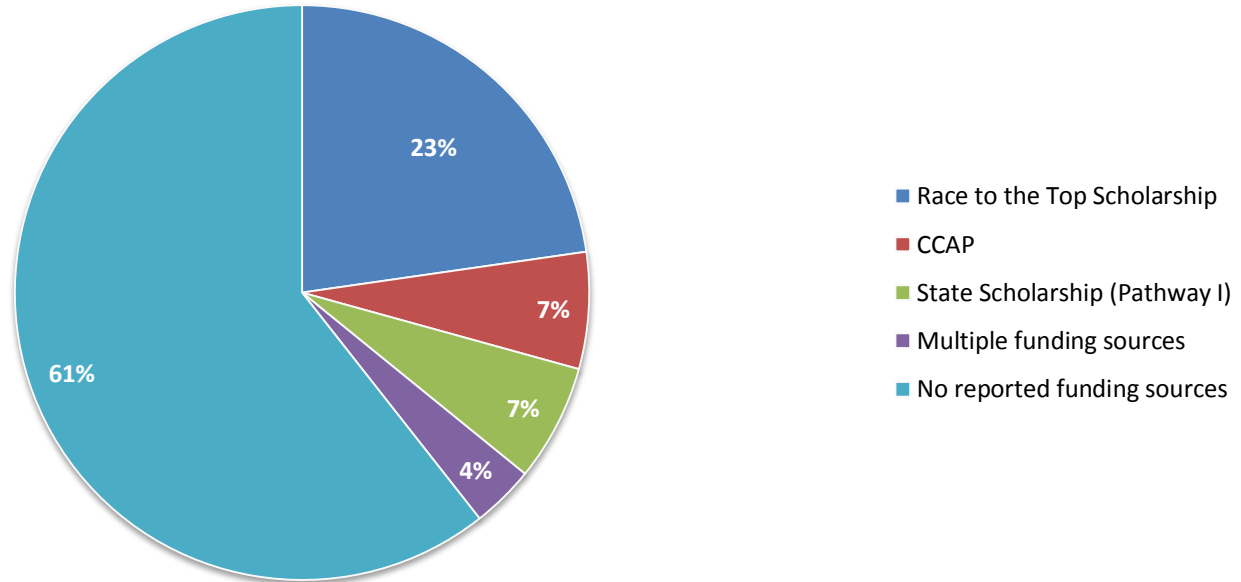

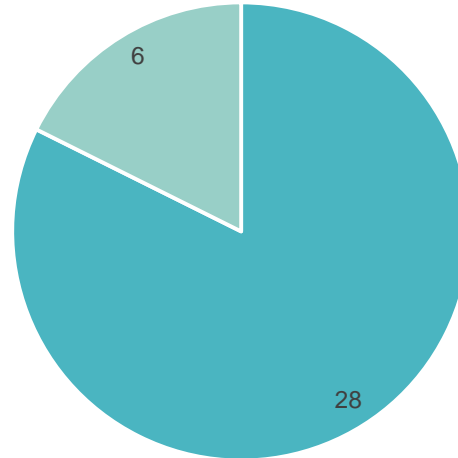
