Enrollment - engaging parents as partners

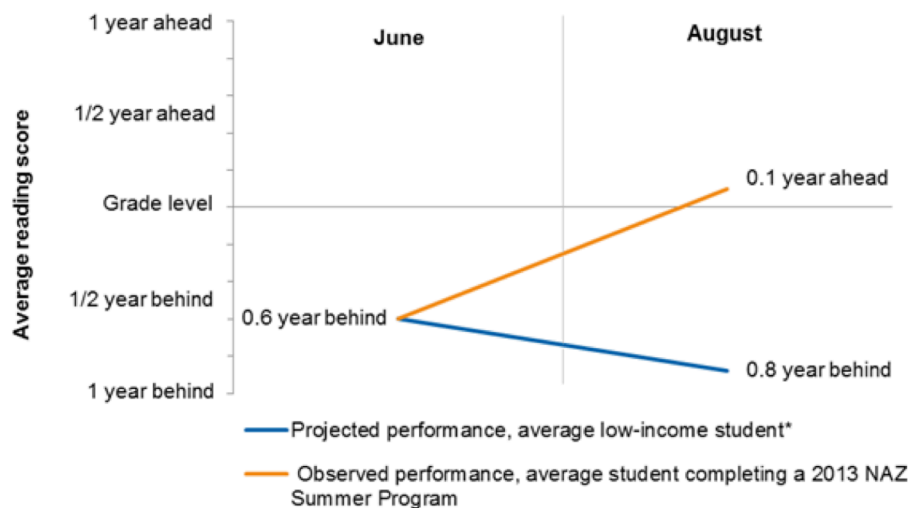

Summer OST Snapshot

Below are the results of our OST analysis in reading for PCYC, Ascension, PQ, and Beacons for Summer 2013. 232 students were enrolled, and 170 completed their programs (completing both the pre-test and post-test) for a completion rate of 73%. Of the 73% of the students who completed both the pre-test and post-test:

- Only 1% (one student) experienced summer slide.
- 64% gained at least half a grade level and 45% gained at least a full grade level during the summer.
- 41% were reading at or above grade level in June, and 56% were reading at or above grade level in August.

These results are from pre- and post-assessments in reading associated with Jerry John's Running Record. The Running Record is an informal reading inventory that was used to provide a broad overview of reading performance for students participating in NAZ OST summer programming. There is no evidence to support a score on the Jerry John's measure as an accurate predictor of performance on the MCAs or other standardized measures of reading.

Whole-family support:**Supporting family success so children can show up ready to learn**

201 families with whole-family support needs successfully accessed navigator area.

Career:

- 111 adults were referred to career area for support.
- 1 adult secured part-time employment
- 17 adults secured full-time employment
- Future reported measure: # and % of families reaching career goal milestones

Housing:

- 44 families who were referred for housing stabilization support
- 22 families had their housing stabilized
- Future reported measure: stability measure over time

Behavioral Health:

- 44 identified needs in children or adults with referrals made
